Re: Service and Utility Works – Tupia Street, Hayden Place and Sir Joseph Banks Park

The design and construction for the Port Botany Container Terminal Expansion is being carried out under deed to Sydney Ports Corporation by Baulderstone Hornibrook Jan de Nul (BH-JDN) Consortium. Construction is due for completion in March 2011.

Works to install and connect new underground telecommunications, electricity and sewer lines has been scheduled to take place on **1 April 2009** in the vicinity of **Tupia Street**. This work includes saw cutting that will take approximately 2 days to complete, followed by excavation works which will take approximately 2-3 weeks to complete.

As we progressively carry about these works we are setting up short term work areas at each site and we request that you do not park near the designated work areas.
