### **Re: Update - Night Time Road Works – Foreshore Road - Installation of the Pedestrian Bridge**

---

The design and construction for the Port Botany Container Terminal Expansion is being carried out under deed to Sydney Ports Corporation by Baulderstone Hornibrook Jan de Nul (BH-JDN) Consortium. Construction is due for completion in March 2011.

You were recently updated for ongoing night works for the construction of the three new intersections on Foreshore Road located at Mill Stream look out, the new boat ramp and the new terminal access road, which has been occurring during May, June and July.

Further night work including asphaltting activities, and installation of concrete barriers will continue throughout July. The installation of girders for the **pedestrian bridge will take place in mid July 2009**. This particular activity will take up to three nights to complete, weather permitting.

There may be some noise associated with the use of cranes, and the reversing beepers of trucks.

During these works there will be some temporary lane closures, and the speed limit will be reduced to 40km/h while this work is completed. Traffic control measures and advisory signage will be in place to assist motorists through the work areas.

Once the works are completed the current number of lanes will remain open in each direction.

Works will occur between Mondays and Fridays from 8.00pm to 5.30am.
