

SYDNEY PORTS CORPORATION HAS ACHIEVED MANY HIGHLIGHTS AND FACED A RANGE OF CHALLENGES DURING THE 2007/08 YEAR, INCLUDING:

# HIGHLIGHTS

- » Developed our own Sustainability Policy with approval from the Board of Sydney Ports.
- » Submitted our Section 170 Register to the Heritage Office as part of our Heritage Asset Management System.
- » Commenced works on the Port Botany Expansion, our largest development project in decades, including enhancement of Penrhyn Estuary and Foreshore Beach.
- » Contributed 100 hours of paid volunteering by Sydney Ports' staff.
- » Trialled a trailer parking ban and reduction of the speed limit for Foreshore Road.
- » Improved safety processes resulting in large decreases in lost time injuries from four last year to one this year and a drop in the lost time injury frequency rate from 10.4 to 1.7.
- » Commenced construction of the 4.5 green star Operations Centre at Port Botany.
- » Initiated container terminal operation and management initiatives through the successful trial and introduction of High Efficiency Container Trucks and the installation of 10 new *TruckCams* at Port Botany.
- » Initiated an internal environmental working group to reduce our consumption of key resources.
- » Completed a stakeholder survey with 64% of those interviewed awarding Sydney Ports an overall satisfaction score of seven out of 10 or higher.
