Re: Update Service and Utility Works – Tupia Street

The design and construction for the Port Botany Container Terminal Expansion is being carried out under deed to Sydney Ports Corporation by Baulderstone Hornibrook Jan de Nul (BH-JDN) Consortium. Construction is due for completion in March 2011.

In 2009, residents were notified on the works to install the new underground telecommunications, electricity and sewer lines in the vicinity of Tupia Street. Works will **recommence on Monday 22 February 2010** to install the new sewer line and will continue to be undertaken intermittently over a **two week period, weather permitting**.

During these works there maybe pedestrian diversions implemented and driveways maybe interrupted. Individual residents will be approached should there be any interruptions to driveways.

The Project is committed to ensuring throughout the works any dug holes or exposed areas will be back filled and made safe. At the completion of all the services works, the affected areas will be temporarily reinstated by the Project.

Final restoration works will be undertaken by City of Botany Bay Council.
