NAVIGATION WARNING
BOTANY BAY

Vessel operators are advised of a NAVIGATION HAZARD adjacent to Port Botany north of a line between Navigation Aid 141 (at Brotherson Dock) and the southern tip of the third runway at Kingsford Smith Airport, commencing 1 October 2009 and continuing until March 2011

Vessel operators are advised that NSW Maritime has designated the area to be a **Construction Zone** for the purpose of container terminal expansion works at Brotherson Dock by the Sydney Ports Corporation and Baulderstone Jan de Nul Port Botany .

CONSTRUCTION ZONE

1. The Construction Zone will be north of a line commencing from the southern end of the third runway of Sydney Kingsford Smith Airport (Parallel Runway 34R) in an east-north-easterly direction, to the south-western extremity of the North Quay of Brotherson Dock, Port Botany. The Construction Zone will be marked with a silt boom, yellow special marks (yellow buoys) and lights at night.
2. The Construction Zone will be signposted as an 8 knot speed restriction zone for all vessels. Penalties apply for non compliance.
3. No anchoring or drifting by recreational vessels is permitted within the Construction Zone. Penalties apply for non compliance.
4. A designated gate displaying port and starboard lateral marks will be establish at the western end of the silt boom.
5. For the purpose of access to the limited areas of the new public boat ramp on **Foreshore Road** a 30 metre wide navigation channel will be established through the Construction Zone marked with yellow special marks (yellow buoys) and lights at night.

NAVIGATION ADVICE

Vessels are advised not to enter the Construction Zone from the temporary navigation channel, and to keep well clear of any service or support craft, plant, machinery or construction equipment. The area is considered a HAZARD TO NAVIGATION, and vessel operators are advised to exercise extreme caution.

Persons operating vessels in the vicinity are reminded of their obligation to maintain their speed at no more than 4 knots within 100 metres of floating plant or work in progress, with vessel wash to be kept to a minimum, and to keep a proper lookout at all times. Penalties apply.

Dredging and reclamation works may be carried out within the Construction Zone 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.
