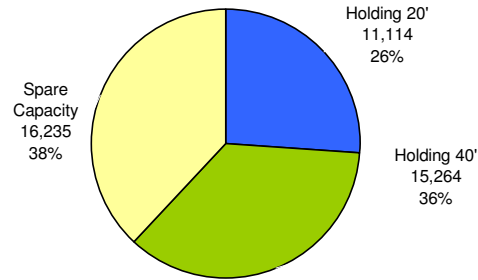

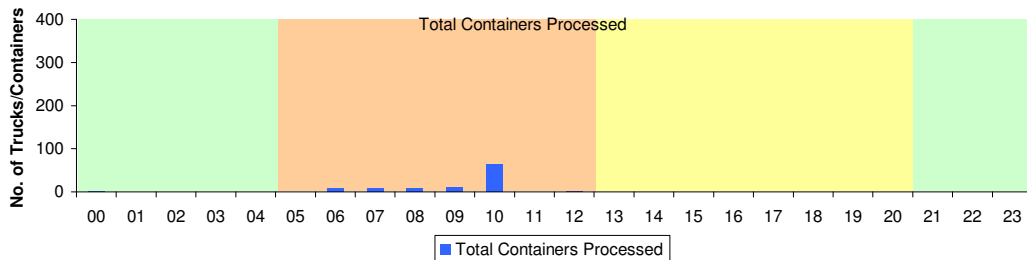

**Container Parks Capacity & Usage (in TEUs)**



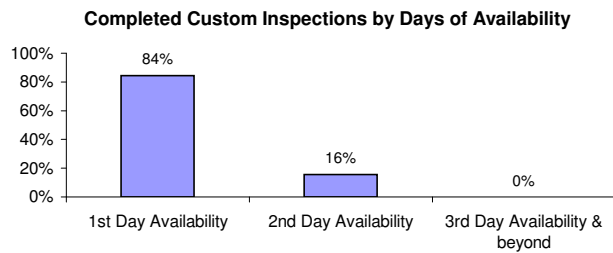
