**Re: Update on Construction Activities - Port Botany Container Terminal Expansion Project**

---

The design and construction for the Port Botany Container Terminal Expansion is being carried out under deed to Sydney Ports Corporation by Baulderstone Jan de Nul Consortium. Construction is due for completion in March 2011.

Works to construct the new bridge to provide access for trucks entering and exiting the new container terminal from Foreshore Road have already commenced.

Piling activities associated with the bridge abutments are scheduled to begin in **mid August 2009**. This activity will take up three (3) weeks to complete, weather permitting.

Piling works will be undertaken during standard working hours, Monday to Friday from 7am to 6pm, and Saturday from 8am to 1pm.

During these works there will be some temporary lane closures, and the speed limit will be reduced to 40km/h while this work is completed. Traffic control measures and advisory signage will be in place to assist motorists through the work areas.

Once the works are completed the current number of lanes will remain open in each direction.
