**Re: Temporary Closure of Ellis Street – Extended to 21 November 2011**

As part of the Port Botany Container Terminal Expansion Project, Sydney Ports Corporation is replacing the current pedestrian crossing of the rail line at Banksia Street with an elevated pedestrian bridge. Abergeldie Contractors have commenced construction of the new bridge.

Please be advised that due to unforeseen delays in the construction works, it is necessary to extend the current road closure on part of Ellis Street at the intersection of Banksia Street as shown below. The road will be closed until 21 November 2011. Vehicle access will be maintained at all times to all properties for this period.
