Description of proposal

The construction and operation of a second bulk liquids berth adjacent to the existing bulk liquids berth at Port Botany; associated infrastructure including: pipelines, marine loading arms, fire protection systems, hose handling gantries, berthing, mooring equipment; and augmentation of existing facilities.

Application of Part 3A

The Director-General of the Department of Planning, as delegate of the Minister for Planning, formed the opinion on 27 March 2007, pursuant to clause 6 of *State Environmental Planning Policy (Major Projects) 2005* (Major Projects SEPP) that the proposal is a project of the kind described in clause 22 of Schedule 1 of the Major Projects SEPP and is therefore declared to be a project to which Part 3A of the *Environmental Planning & Assessment Act 1979* applies for the purposes of section 75B of that Act.
